The Opening Ceremony of the **38th FAI World Gliding Championships** for the Open, 18m, and 20m Multi-seat classes in Uvalde, Texas USA, will be held in 4 weeks. Several pilots are now in Uvalde training and containers carrying gliders and equipment are beginning to arrive at the airfield.

Updated airspace and waypoint data v3 issued 19-July, 2024

v3 has been issued to correct an **error found in the v1 airspace file** (some airspace incorrectly shown as forbidden). There was no v2. Both airspace and waypoints are designated as v3.

The waypoint file was updated with some additional information. **NO WAYPOINTS WERE ADDED OR DELETED, AND NO WAYPOINT NUMBERS WERE CHANGED**.

Also note that there is intentionally no waypoint #2.

In addition to the files posted on SoaringSpot, the files have also been posted to the <u>Worldwide</u> <u>Soaring Turnpoint Exchange</u>. However, please note that only the .CUP format waypoint file and Openair (.txt) airspace file on SoaringSpot are official for scoring purposes.

AVOID PENALTIES: Things you need to know about Uvalde airspace

- The airspace file that comes with your flight computer is not accurate enough for the WGC.
 You MUST use the one available on SoaringSpot to accurately show and avoid forbidden (i.e. penalty) airspace.
- 2. **PENALTY** airspace is any airspace coded as **Class A, B, C, P, or R.**
- 3. Class A airspace is everything above 18,000' MSL, there is no Class A below that.
- 4. Regardless of what your map says, for the purposes of the contest all other **PENALTY** airspace (B, C, P, and R) areas extend upward to 18,000 MSL. YOU MAY NEVER OVERYFLY THEM.
- 5. Class D airspace is not forbidden, but you must establish radio contact with the facility before you enter it. The top of the airspace is as shown on current charts.
- 6. The penalty airspace that defines the border with Mexico does not exactly match the Rio Grande River. It begins a small distance inside the USA. DO NOT depend on visual avoidance of the river. Rely on the airspace file for proper clearance. See this graphic for an example.
